Title:	Group 1 Phonemes			
Aims:	 The learners develop and practise: Phonemic awareness and phonics knowledge Letter sounds relationships Short vowels Group 1 consonants – <i>s</i>, <i>a</i>, <i>t</i>, <i>p</i>, <i>i</i>, <i>n</i> Blending to form 2 and 3-letter words Learn how to combine letter sounds (blending) to make words Learn how to identify letter sounds in words and segment them to spell Develop handwriting and letter-formation skills 			
Age/Level:	7–8 years (Gr 2 South Africa)			
Time:	30 minutes per week x 2 weeks			
Materials:	erials: Chant: " <i>The short vowel song</i> " (pdf to project via data projector) Phonics cards with pictures and letter cards Real objects (realia) Audio recordings – chants and phonics cards Stationery

Introduction:	Use the chant: "The short vowel song"		
Listening and Speaking (5 minutes)	(NB: Listen to the audio clip and practise the chant before the lesson as part of your preparation)		
	 Display the pdf of the chant and play the audio clip Say the chant with the learners pointing to the words Learners repeat after and then with you Practise and say this chant at least 3 times 		
New knowledge: Phonemic Awareness and Phonics	Session 1 (Week 1) How to teach phonemic awareness and phonics: (see Teacher notes)		
(20 minutes x 2)	 Display each phonic letter card and play audio/say each sound out loud. Learners repeat 3 times with teacher: <i>s</i>, <i>a</i>, <i>t</i>, <i>p</i>, <i>i</i>, <i>n</i> 		
	 2. Point at the pictures on the phonics chart and play the audio Learners repeat the sound and the word with the audio clip. Teacher holds up each phonics card and says: Tell me the sound Write it in the air Give me words that have this sound Do an action for each word e.g. <i>s</i> – snake, sand, sun 		
	 3. Main activity: Blending (see Teacher notes) Make cards of letters (s, a, t, p, i, n) on paper or card Practise blending by playing with vowel cards a, i and consonant cards t, n e.g. <i>Tebo says: Say the sound:</i> Show the a card Show the t card <i>Tebo says: Say the sound a and t</i> Practise blending by clapping: <i>Tebo says: Clap a and t sounds together 3 times</i> Put a and t sound cards together to make the word and write or paste it on chalkboard Let learners read the word 3 times: <i>at</i> Repeat with the a and n, i and n, and i and t cards 		
	4. Practise reading the flash cards with the 2-letter words: at, an, it, in		
	 End the lesson: Complete Phonemic Awareness and Phonics 1 Activity 1: I know my sounds Watch the video <i>Drive Thru Blending</i> (see resources) as part of your preparation 		
Conclusion: (5 minutes)	Repeat the chant: "The short vowel song"		





New knowledge: Phonemic Awareness and Phonics (20 minutes x 2)	 Session 2 (Week 2) 1. Review: Review the phonics cards (s, a, t, p, i, n) Instruct learners: Say the sound and give me a word Review the 2-letter words at, an, it, in phonemes Play a game: When I say a and t I get a-t / a and n I get a-n / i and n I get i-n / i and t I get i-t Teacher shows the letter cards and displays the 2-letter words on the chalkboard Teacher points to the word and the children repeat each word 3 times 2. Main activity: Practise blending with 3 letters and build 3-letter words consonant vowel consonant (CVC) Watch the video Drive Thru Blending (see resources) as part of your preparation 			
	How to make 3-letter CVC words (see Teacher notes on onset and rime)	Word list		
	 Play game with your letter cards a and t Show the a and t cards Clap and say <i>a</i> and <i>t</i> phonemes (learners) Show picture of cat, mat, rat, bat Say the word and ask learners to say the letter sounds they hear in <i>c-a-t</i>, <i>m-a-t</i>, <i>r-a-t</i>, <i>b-a-t</i> Make each of these words using letter cards Call 3 learners and give them the letter cards that make each of the 3-letter words Ask learners to give you other 3-letter words with <i>at</i> phoneme sound Use the letter cards and make these words Call 3 learners and give them the letter words with <i>at</i> phoneme sound Bearners and give them the letter cards that make each of the 3-letter words 	a-t c-a-t m-a-t f-a-t b-a-t s-a-t r-a-t a-n c-a-n m-a-n p-a-n r-a-n v-a-n i-t b-i-t	c-at m-at f-at b-at s-at r-at c-an m-an p-an r-an v-an b-it
