Term 1	Lesson 3 Weeks 5 and 6		
Title:	Group 3 Phonemes		
Aims:	 The learners develop and practise: Phonemic awareness and phonics knowledge Letter-sound relationships Short vowels Group 3 phonemes g, o, u, I, b Blending and segmenting with CVC and CVCC words Handwriting and letter-formation skills Decoding and spelling skills Making rhyming words and word families with short vowels and consonant blends Making and reading sentences using sight words and decodable words (blending and segmenting) 		
Age/Level:	7–8 years (Gr 2 South Africa)		
Time:	30 minutes per week x 2 weeks		
Materials:	Chant: "Do they rhyme?" (pdf to project via data projector) Phonics cards with pictures Letter cards Flash cards (recycled cardboard) Real objects (realia) Audio recordings – chants and phonics cards Photocopy of Phonemic Awareness and Phonics 3 Activity 1 Stationery

Introduction:

Listening and Speaking (5 minutes)

Use the chant: "Do they rhyme?"

(NB: Listen to the audio clip and practise the chant before the lesson as part of your preparation.)

- Display the pdf of the chant and play the audio clip
- Say the chant with the learners pointing to the words
- · Learners repeat after and then with you
- Practise and say this chant at least 3 times

New knowledge:

Phonemic Awareness and Phonics (20 minutes x 2)

Session 1 (Week 5)

How to teach phonemic awareness and phonics (see Teacher notes)

- 1. Revision:
- Phonemes **g**, **o**, **u**, **l**, **b** using phonics cards

2. Audio

- Point at the pictures on the phonics chart and play the audio
- Learners repeat the sound and the word with the audio clip

3. Main activity:

- Make CVC words with the short vowels o and u
- Make CVC words using the vowel o orally, practically (use letter cards), with the consonants from Groups 1, 2 and 3: not, hop, rob, rod, log
- Make CVC words using the vowel u orally, practically (use letter cards), with the consonants from Groups 1, 2 and 3: but, run, mum, jug, tub, pup
- Write a list of words with the short vowels o and u on the board: rob, rub, cob, cub, jog, jug, got, gut
- Learners practise saying the words as you point to them
- They copy and draw pictures for the list of words in their Classwork books

End the lesson:

• Copy and draw pictures for the list of words in their Classwork books and complete Phonemic Awareness and Phonics 3 Activity 1

Conclusion: (5 minutes)

Repeat the chant: "Do they rhyme?"

- 3-letter CVC words with short vowels a, e, i, o, u
- 3. Main activity:
- Consonant blends: make CVCC words:
 - **cr** crab
 - **br** bran
 - tr trip
 - **dr** drop
 - **pr** pram
 - **fr** frog

 Teacher explains Phonemic Awareness and Phonics 3 Activity 2 to the whole class

Repeat the chant: "Do they rhyme?"
