Aims:				
Age/Level:	8–9 years (Gr 3 South Africa)			
Time:	30 minutes per week x 2 weeks			
Materials:	Chant: "The ck chant" Phonics cards with pictures Letter cards Flash cards and sentence cards (recycled cardboard) Real objects (realia) Audio recordings – chants and phonics cards Photocopies of Phonemic Awareness and Phonics 2 Activities 1 & 2 Stationery			

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Introduction:

Listening and Speaking (5 minutes)

Use the chant: "The ck chant"

(NB: Listen to the audio clip and practise the chant before the lesson as part of your preparation)

- Display the pdf of the chant and play the audio clip
- Say the chant with the learners pointing to the words
- · Learners repeat after and then with you
- Practise and say this chant at least 3 times

New knowledge:

Phonemic Awareness and Phonics (20 minutes)

Session 1

How to teach phonemic awareness and phonics: (see Teacher notes)

1. Revision:

Short and long vowels, vowel digraphs, consonant blends and digraphs

2. Phonics chart and audio:

- Point at the pictures on the phonics chart and play the audio
- Learners repeat the sound and the word with the audio clip

3. Main activity:

Rhyming words and word families with ck and ff

sack	peck	pick	buff	cliff
back	deck	sick	cuff	stiff
pack	neck	lick	huff	sniff
rack	check	kick	puff	whiff
black	duck	trick	gruff	

• Read sentence cards with the class:

Check the door and lock the house.

The wolf screamed, I will huff and puff and blow the house down.

- Whole class reads each sentence 3 times
- Encourage individuals/small groups of learners to read the sentences and perform actions
- Learners copy the sentence cards and draw pictures for each sentence in classwork books

End the lesson:

- Phonics 2 Activity 1: Spelling, making words, reading and writing stories
- Explain Activity 1 during the GGR session

Conclusion:

(5 minutes)

Repeat the chant: "The ck chant"

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Assessment:

- Spelling, segmenting and blending, reading and writing stories
- Use Phonics 2 Activity 1 as an Assessment Activity for Term 1

Session 2

- 1. Review:
- Consonant blends and digraphs

2. Use the chant: "The ck chant"

(NB: Listen to the audio clip and practise the chant before the lesson as part of your preparation)

3. Main activity:

- Making words with the consonant digraphs
 - **II** as in ball, bell, bill, bull, doll
 - zz as in jazz, fizzy, drizzle, buzz
 - **ng** as in sang, sing, song, lung, swing, thing
- Rhyming words and word families with *II*, *zz*, *ng*

4. Sentence cards:

• Read sentence cards with the class:

Dad will sell balls, dolls and shells at the mall.

I fell in the hall when I rang the bell.

- Whole class reads each sentence 3 times
- Encourage individuals/small groups of learners to read the sentences and perform actions
- Learners copy the sentence cards and draw pictures for each sentence in classwork books (see Teacher notes)

End the lesson:

- Phonemic Awareness and Phonics Activity 1: Spelling, making words, reading and comprehension
- Explain Activity 1 in the GGR session

Conclusion:	Repeat the chant: "The ck chant"
